URGENT: IMPORTANT PARKING POLICY UPDATE

I hope this message finds you well. We have recently implemented a new parking policy that is crucial for the success of our upcoming tournaments. It is of utmost importance that every member of our club adheres to this policy, as failure to do so may jeopardise our access to the facility for future events.

Worden only - Hi Five Festival

Inferno Car Parking Pass: Each team will receive 3 parking passes and 1 for the coaching team per club. These passes are mandatory for access to the tournament site at Worden.

Full Car Requirement: To ensure efficient use of parking space, every vehicle must have a minimum of four occupants. Failure to comply will result in denied access.

Overflow Parking: For those without parking passes, the overflow car park is located at Civic Centre, W Paddock, Leyland PR25 1DH. It is just a 6-minute walk from the site.

Leaving Site: All teams must leave site after their last game or presentation if they are in medal positions. For U7/8 THIS MEANS 13:00 at the latest.

Afternoon teams: do not turn up before 30 minutes before your first start game

A mini-bus service: will run from 07:45 - 8:30 every 6 minutes for morning teams.

Neighborhood Restrictions:



Please refrain from parking in the neighbourhood in front of residential houses, even **if it is legally permissible**. This is crucial for maintaining good relations with the local community.

If we get complaints, no more Netball Tournaments; We can not stress how important this is for our netball community.

Action Required:

Please disseminate this information to all club members promptly. We depend on everyone's cooperation to ensure the success of our tournaments and secure future access to the facility.

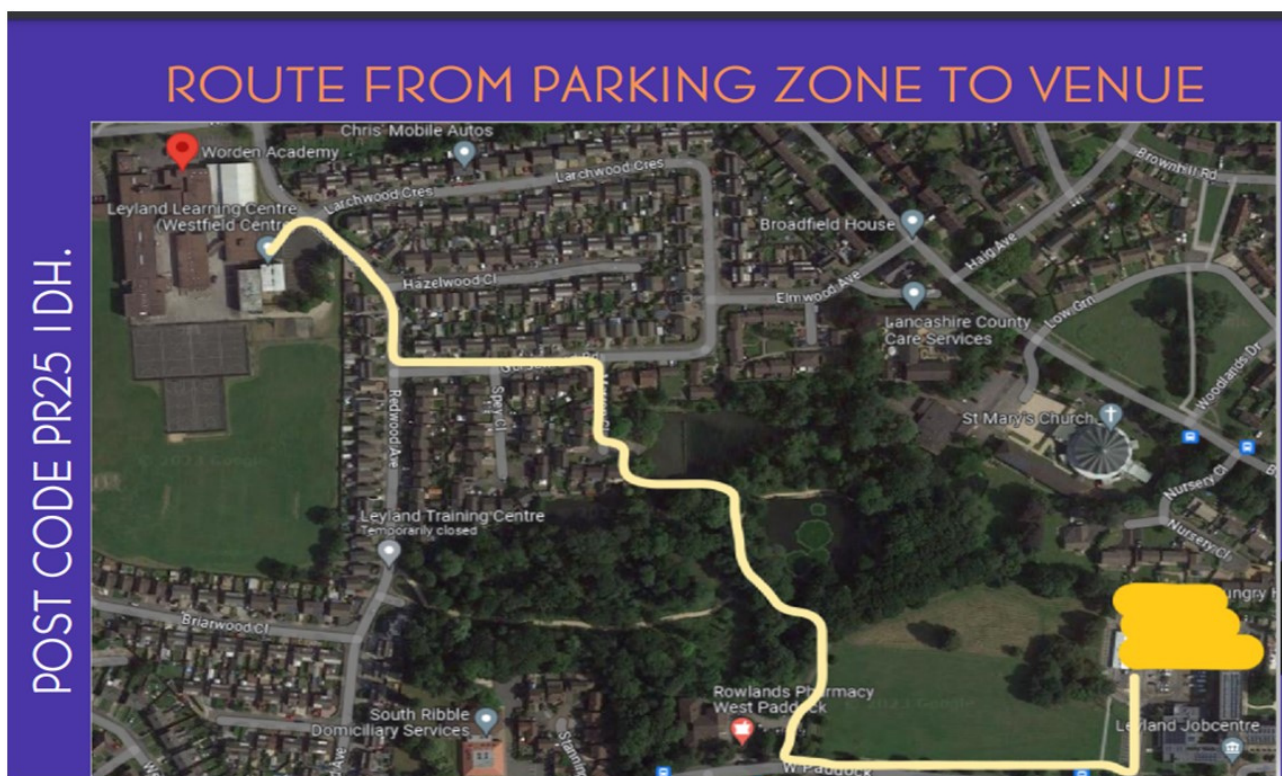

1 Person on Zone 3 entrance 7:30 - 8:30 - This is for primary officials and coaches, people there all day and overflow once all these people parked. You must not double park on block the entrance through to school, there has to be enough entrance for an ambulance to get through. **Umpire Team.**

Parking Process:

- Officials and first come, first serve on Leyland sports association car park. Access with four people in car only.
- Teams must coordinate to maximise car occupancy, ensuring four individuals in each vehicle for access.
- When site car park is full, Overflow car park is situated on your left as you enter the site from the main road as show in Arrow Red. **This is pay and display.**
- You must leave site when you have finished all your games to allow the PM teams to come on site.

FA Section at Leyland:

- Strictly no parking in the FA section at Leyland.

You must leave site when you have finished all your games to allow the PM teams to come on site.
